A Closer Look at NIBRS Reporting

What information do you collect using NIBRS?

Incident information on Crimes Against Persons, Crimes Against Property, and Crimes Against Society (Group A offenses) are collected.



Arrest only (Group B offenses) information is collected on all other offenses <u>except</u> traffic offenses. Driving Under the Influence is the only traffic offense reported.

Using NIBRS, all reportable offenses in an incident are reported, thus giving a true depiction of what is occurring in the community. There are State and Federal funding and program opportunities tied to collecting and reporting crime statistics.
